## As Related to James 4:8

- 1. This verse specifically calls into view Ps 24:4 (1-6) and the need for spotlessness before God that is not merely external in nature (clean hands), but also genuine within (pure heart). (Ps 15)
- 2. James is exhorting these believers to repent, confess their sins and be made clean by the Blood of Christ.

## J. Vernon McGee

"If the only ones who are going to ascend into the hill of the Lord are those who have 'clean hands and a pure heart,' and those who have not 'lifted up' their souls 'unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully,' I guess I won't be there. That leaves me out. But I am going to be there, because I am going to be there *in Christ*."

- 3. He properly recognizes that the outward acts of unrighteousness described at the beginning of this chapter are the direct result of their ongoing carnality.
- 4. Ps 24:4,5 and James 4:10 highlight that their repentance must be accompanied with an attitude of humility in order to experience sustained spiritual growth.
- 5. The result of this spiritual growth will be a purity of heart that will be outwardly manifest in love, peace, grace, etc.
- 6. Believers who have clean hands, a pure heart, and are humble before God will be exalted by Him at the proper time.
