- Conclusions
 - O God created us with the capacity for relationships with Him and other people.
 - O The Fall severed our relationship with God and damaged our capacity for friendship with others.
 - O When we are born again we can once again be "friends" of God and have a restored capacity for friendships based upon integrity and love.
 - O The Bible presents examples of wonderful friendships that are based on integrity and love.
 - O The Bible also presents friendships that are unhealthy and harmful to the believer.
 - O Healthy friendships centered in Christ's love are a tremendous blessing and can be a source of spiritual strengthening for both parties.
 - O When the people involved in a friendship move away from God, the friendship can become perilous for one or both parties.
 - O Unbelievers can form friendships that are a temporal benefit, but deep bonds of friendship that have eternal meaning are entered into only by believers that have a renewed capacity for personal relationships through the Holy Spirit.
